ATYFC

Currently registering players ahead of next season, with hopefully around 300 members from U7 - U18, boys and girls.

Working closely with ATFC; a raft of players training weekly for an U23s team with a number making it to the fringes of the senior side. ATYFC are hopeful this will become a regular feature next season with more players making Alresford Town debuts.

ARFC

The first training session of the year was attended by 24 players. New committee places were filled at the recent AGM. Rugby minis is expanding to cover U12s, and there are approx. 120 members. ARFC hope to reignite the Women's team and will have a stand at Winchester University freshers fair to advertise to prospective players. This year free rugby is being offered to the Senior team.

Planning permission has been submitted for a storage facility on the lower pitch. The approved cladding to the existing container by the ARC will take place at the same time as a new storage facility.
